

The HistoryMobile Returns to the Depot!

The Depot Community Room is hosting a visit from the Kentucky Historical Society's HistoryMobile with a special Abraham Lincoln exhibit.

The Kentucky Historical Society's HistoryMobile is a mobile museum featuring exhibits on Kentucky history. Lincoln's life in Kentucky will be featured in a new HistoryMobile exhibit, "Kentucky's Abraham Lincoln." This special exhibit will be stationed in front of the Depot Monday, March 31, and Tuesday, April 1.

This 300-square-foot exhibit sponsored by the Kentucky Historical Society explores Lincoln's frontier childhood, his career from log house to the White House, and his struggles to end slavery and lead the nation through the Civil War. The exhibit contains artifacts, images, as well as audio, video and interactive elements to appeal to a variety of learners.

The exhibit will be open on those days 10am- 4pm. Admission is free. The exhibit is handicap accessible.
